<p><b>1</b> Read them together! The adult reads them first and then you read them.</p>	<p><b>2</b> Keyword detectives! Pick a word and see how many times you can find it in a book or magazine.</p>	<p><b>3</b> Speed Read! Set a timer and see how many words you can read before time runs out. Can you beat your speed read record?</p>	<p><b>4</b> Keyword Hunt! Hide your keywords around your home then search for them. Read and write them as you find them.</p>	<p><b>5</b> Rainbow Writing! Pick a word, read it and then write each letter in a different colour</p>
<p><b>6</b> Play some reading games on <b>ICT Games</b>: <a href="https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/literacy.html">https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/literacy.html</a></p>	<p><b>7</b> Make another set of keywords and play Pairs and Snap!</p>	<p><b>8</b> Keyword splat! Spread your keywords out and when a grown up says the word splat it with your hand.</p>	<p><b>9</b> Dice Game! Pick a word and roll a dice (or pick a number). Write it the correct amount of times.</p>	<p><b>10</b> Do you have some stairs or steps? Put your keywords on them and read them as you go up.</p>
<p><b>11</b> Keyword sort! Read, look at then sort your keywords into groups. Can you spot anything the same? Does it have a tricky bit? Does it start with the same sound?</p>	<p><b>12</b> Silly Voices! Read your keywords in as many silly voices as you can think of. You could use a spooky, sad or happy voice and maybe even read them like a pirate.</p>	<p><b>13</b> Musical keywords! Spread your keywords on the floor, play some music and dance around. When the music stops, read the word you freeze on.</p>	<p><b>14</b> Keyword Noughts and Crosses! Instead of drawing noughts and crosses pick a keyword each to write.</p>	<p><b>15</b> Speed write! Pick a keyword and set a timer. How many times can you write it?</p>
